Component 1

- Developing caregiver-focused social media messaging for a public awareness campaign
- Connecting a state health department and their partner organization with program developers to identify strategies to scale and sustain the REACH caregiver program
- Selecting and prioritizing caregiving goals and strategies to include in the state ADRD plan
- Summarizing evidence on costeffectiveness and Medicaid savings of caregiver programs to share with state legislature

Component 2

- Provide resources to inform selection of evaluation metrics for caregiver programs
- Identifying and developing caregiverspecific content for a dementia-focused training curriculum for healthcare providers and public health professionals
- Selecting a framework and measures to assess sustainability of caregiving strategies
- Recommending resources for caregivers and healthcare and services providers to include in online state
